Message from the Founder & CEO



Starting in June, NKR activity returned to pre-pandemic levels with October setting a record for the most KPD transplants in a single month. As our volumes continue to grow, patient wait times continue to drop. Because wait times have dropped so much over the years, we have added a new category in the Wait Time Distribution chart for patients matched and transplanted in under 45 days. In the third quarter, a remarkable 49% of patients were matched and transplanted in under 45 days.

During the third quarter, there was a dramatic improvement in the swap failure rate, dropping from 33% in the prior two quarters to 13% in the third quarter. This significant improvement was primarily driven by widespread adoption of virtual cross-matching and the increasing accuracy of this methodology. Most centers now exceed a 95% virtual cross-match accuracy rate. Our goal is to achieve a 95% accuracy rate at all NKR Member Centers by the end of 2020.

The Voucher Program continues to gain popularity with over half of Good Samaritan donor candidates choosing to become Family Voucher donors and over a third of paired donors now choosing to enter the Standard Voucher Program. In the third quarter we deployed the Voucher Education Module to better educate donor candidates about the advantages of youcher donation. Early results indicate that only 10% of donor candidates choose to opt out of the Voucher Program and about 50% indicate an interest in learning more about the Voucher Program.


This decoupling of pairs is particularly important as we see the increasing success of the Kidney for Life program. To date, we have found 11 low eplet mismatches including 5 zero mismatch matches across the 7 centers.







Microsite Growth



Patients Matched and/or Transplanted by Center






Patients with 3G Typing by Center





Kidney Donations by Donor Type









Paired Recipients and Standard Voucher Recipient




Pool Composition by cPRA



Wait times of Patients Transplanted During prior 12 months








Median Wait in Days by ABO



Transplanted Recipients by cPRA










Remote Donations by Donor Type
















Uncoupling Trend






VEM Good Samaritan Donor Candidates

VEM Donor Candidates Who Know The Recipient


